

In addition to our fresh bakery and seasonal just-picked produce, you will find a number of your Market favorites from the past few years.* Due to the pandemic, we, unfortunately, do not have access to everything this year. Still, we commit to doing our best to stock our Market with the highest quality available produce. Please read the following changes to know what to expect before visiting the farm and shopping in our Market.

Market hours are 9 am - 6 pm. We will have an employee at the door to greet you and answer any questions you have or concerns regarding our changes due to Covid-19. Facial masks are required to enter.

Employee Protocol. Each of our employees has committed to staying home if they have experienced any symptoms or have knowingly been exposed to COVID. To help stop the spread of Covid-19, we ask you to do the same. All employees will have their temperature taken upon arrival each day. Each employee will be wearing a mask and or be at least six feet away whenever possible. Regular hand-washing breaks will be taken.

Shopping in our Market. Social distancing is mandatory, and facial masks are required while you shop in our Market. According to the CDC, children ages 2 and under should not wear a mask. We may have to limit the number of guests in our Market at any given time, per the state of Illinois guidelines. If that is the case during your visit, the process will be marked and following it should be simple and straightforward. We ask that you leave extra family members outside and only send in the person doing the shopping. Although this may sound frustrating, it will speed up the process dramatically for everyone involved. PLEASE do not leave young children in your car while you shop. If you do not have another adult with you, bring them in the Market and, for their safety, keep them by your side. We will be as contactless as possible during your check out process, so no receipt will be issued unless you request one. Cash and credit cards will be accepted, no. **Please note that we will not be selling any gift items at this time.*

While experiencing our Pick-Your-Own apples and or pumpkins. Facial masks are required for check-in, on our tractor-driven rides to the pumpkin patch (we will not provide tractor rides to the apple orchard) and anytime you cannot maintain a six-foot distance from our staff or our guests. We encourage you to bring a wagon or stroller for your children when coming to the farm to pick apples. The walk to enter the orchard is about 1/3 – 1/2 mile, depending on what variety of apples we are offering the day you are at the farm. Please read the signs as you walk up to the check-in to know what you would like to purchase and pick. We also request that you plan on using a credit or debit card to limit contact during your check-in purchase. Before you enter the orchard, please wash your hands or use your hand sanitizer and do the same after picking to stop the spread of germs. Please no sampling of fruit or vegetables in the fields.

Due to the pandemic, we are not offering group events and ask that you do not linger for long periods at the farm. Our goal is to have ample space for everyone to spend time at the farm while protecting and keeping all guests safe.

We care about our customers. We take pride in our business and want you to know that your confidence in us is critical. We want to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to do business safely. We commit to continue to clean and sanitize our Market. All shopping carts and items commonly touched will be sanitized whenever possible. We would be grateful if you would help us by only touching what you plan on purchasing. We are thankful we have a large amount of open space at the farm. That will make it easier for each of us to practice social distancing.
